



Footy Tipping Competition Terms and Conditions

1. Current financial members of Wagga RSL are eligible for the 2023 NRL & AFL Tipping competition. The tipping competition will be open for entries from Tuesday 21st of February, 2023 until the final round of the season for both codes.
2. Entry into this competition is free for members only.
3. Members are welcome to participate in both the NRL & the AFL tipping competition.
4. **MEMBERS MUST PLACE THEIR OWN TIPS. MEMBERS FOUND TO BE PLACING OTHER MEMBERS' TIPS OR HAVE ORGANISED SOMEONE ELSE TO PLACE THEIR TIPS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
5. This competition is open to financial Wagga RSL Club members only.
6. Members are required to swipe their current financial membership card at the sign in terminal to complete their tips for the week. The terminals are located at the main entrance of the Club and the sports bar entrance. Tipping is to be completed during trading hours and must be submitted 10 minutes prior to each game. This means you can enter all your tips early in the week and then change your mind and alter your selections 10 minutes prior to the game.
7. Each week the member needs to submit their tips for the upcoming NRL & AFL round. This is to be done in person at the sign in terminal, by the assigned deadline. All the points will be tallied and displayed on the terminal at both clubs on the following Tuesday after each round.
8. Members can submit their tips for multiple rounds and can also go in and change them and resubmit changes at any time. Every time a member submits their tips a print out from the terminal is issued.
9. Points will be allocated as follows;
 - 0 Points awarded for a loss
 - 1 Point awarded for a win
 - 2 Points awarded for NRL draw
 - 4 Points awarded for AFL draw
 - 1 Point awarded for a full correct roundIf selections are not made, then a win by the away team will be awarded a point – up to a maximum of 3 points per round.

- 4 After the final round, all points will be calculated and the person(s) with the most points will be declared the winner(s). Followed by a second place & third place.

Prizes:

1st = \$600

2nd = \$300

3rd = \$100

Total = \$1000 for each code of football

- 5 TOTAL VALUE OF PRIZES \$2,000
- 6 Prizes will be put on the members card in points
- 7 A member can win prizes in both codes of football
- 8 If there is more than one (1) winner for each place, the prize money is to be split evenly amongst winners. For example: In the event that there are two winners, 1st and 2nd place prize money is to be shared. If there is one (1) winner and two (2) participants finish in an equal second place, 1st place will be won outright and 2nd + 3rd place prize money is to be shared.
- 9 Winners must present their current financial Wagga RSL Club membership card and another form of identification to collect their prize. If the member refuses to show identification, then they cannot claim a prize. One form of identification must have members photo.
- 10 Directors, management, employees & contractors and their staff may not participate in this competition.
- 11 Any discrepancies in relation to points awarded are to be discussed with the club's Marketing Manager, whose decision is final.
- 12 Should any of the rules of this free competition necessitate any change, members will be notified.
